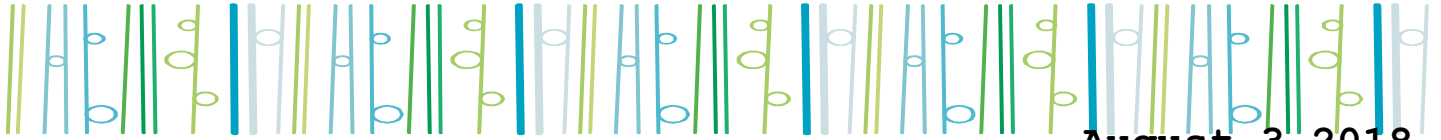


# 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Safari News
