## What's been happening in our

 classroom this week?
## Week 13

In math, we are working on place value and understanding that the two digits of a two-digit number represent a group of tens and ones. For example, 10 is a group of ten ones called a ten and 13 is a group of ten and 3 ones.

In Reading, we've been using the key details in a literary (fiction) text to help us retell the story. We practiced identifying the major key details by using the Beginning (characters \& setting), Middle (problem) and Ending (solution) to help us retell a story. This prevents focusing on every single little detail in a story. We also discussed and identified the central message or lesson of the story.

In Science, we learned about the pumpkin life cycle and that a pumpkin is a living thing since it grows and changes. We know that pumpkins naturally decompose. We learned that if the pumpkin plant doesn't get enough sunlight, air, and water that it won't grow either. If we pick the yellow flower, we know that the pattern of the pumpkin life cycle is broken and it won't grow into a pumpkin anymore.

In Writing, we are learning to indent and start our writing with a topic sentence and use temporal words (First, Next, Then, Last) to add our supporting details. We are practicing how to proofread/edit our work by color coding. We circle capitals with green and end punctuation with red. Most students have a goal of writing 4 complete sentences on their own this quarter. This quarter, we are focusing on writing informational or how-to writing pieces.
