What's been happening in our classroom this week?

Week 2

In Math, we learned about number patterns and being able to identify what the pattern is (+1, +2, -1 or -2) and continuing the pattern. We used our number lines as a tool to help figure out the pattern. We learned that "more" means adding and "less" means subtracting or taking away.

In Reading, we discussed different text features of informational texts, such as: table of contents, bold print words, glossary, titles and headings. We know that the numbers listed on the Table of Contents page tells us the page number to turn to to read more about that topic (which ties into math and knowing the order of numbers on the number line).

In Social Studies, we've been learning about self-control by following these 3 steps: Stop, Think, Act. We also learned about the qualities of a good friend/citizen and how words can be hurtful (ask your child about the inside of 1 of the apples).
