

## Week 3

In Math, we finished Ch.1 on number patterns and started a new chapter on number bonds. Below is an example. Number bonds is just a visual representation of ways to add two numbers (parts) together to make a whole. We checked our work with a number line, ten frame and a balance.



In Reading, we discussed different text features of informational texts, such as: index, caption, diagram with labels and text boxes (Example: "Did You Know...?" or "Fun Facts"). We also verified the pages from the Index to make sure a particular word we were looking for was found on that page/s.

In Social Studies, we've been learning more about self-control by following these 3 steps: Stop, Think, Act. We learned more about Community Helpers and how important all jobs are to make a community operate.

In Writing, we worked on our first piece and learned how to proofread/edit our work by color coding. We circle capitals with green and end punctuation with red. We are learning to start our writing with a topic sentence and use temporal words to add our supporting details. Character Counts Pillar: Trustworthiness
